## Habitat Restoration with San Diego Audubon

**Who:** The entire community is invited to volunteer. If you're under 18, you must bring signed permission forms, available by request. If you're under 16, you must attend with an adult.

**What:** Volunteers will help restore habitat by planting native vegetation for the variety of birds and other wildlife that call this area home. We will also be constructing brush boxes and erosion wattles that will be used this rainy-season to control erosion and loss of habitat throughout the uplands of the Reserve.

**Where:** Meet at the entrance to Border Field State Park. From the I-5 South, exit Coronado Ave in Imperial Beach. Go straight from the off-ramp onto Hollister St. Continue down Hollister until you reach Monument Rd. Turn West on Monument Rd until you reach the park entrance.

**What to Bring:** Volunteers must work in long pants and boots or sturdy shoes. Please wear sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat. We will provide work gloves and tools.

**What to Expect:** We will ask all volunteers to sign-in upon arrival. After that, we will all convene for a brief project orientation and safety talk. Then we'll hand out tools and get to work.
